
Bo Christian Larsson, Murena and Tobias Yves Zintel are working on a performative installation that is based on the interaction of music, video and performance. The three artists come from different disciplines: Bo Christian Larsson works based on performance featuring installation, music, excerpts from films, theater and phenomena of popular culture. Murena, on the other hand, centers on variations of music as the basis of his artistic practice. He combines different elements of the history of music, plays them off against each other, and ultimately bypasses mere deconstruction to arrive at a "piece." Tobias Yves Zittel works with video and photography, in the center stands the production of videos at the margins of art, film, theater and pop. Visiting artist in Berlin will be Johannes Buss, whose work is based on extracting imagery and objects from popular culture, politics and economics out of their original context. He alters and recombines this material in form of installations, sculptures, drawings and videos.

Special guest is the graphic designer Håkan Larsson, who has created the book "On And On Is How We Are" that is being released that evening.
